Holiday Homework 2018

Your holiday tasks are designed to broaden your photography horizon. You will be asked to capture a range of photography subjects so that you can experiment shooting different genres. You will need to **collect 1 photographic image as inspiration for each genre that you will photograph**. You will need to capture **15 Photographs in total**. This can be completed using any camera, including your mobile phone. These images will need to be placed in to a PowerPoint presentation and will be presented to the class upon arriving to school on the first day back of term 1 2018.

Tasks

1. Explore Portraiture and **Photograph 3 portraits**
Experiment with natural light at various times of the day. Remember that your subject must be looking at you in order to be classified a portrait.
2. Explore Architecture and **Photograph 2 photos that represent Architecture**
Try to explore the sculptural quality of buildings. Look at various angles and try to change your point of view.
3. Explore landscape/nature photography and **Photograph 3 images to depict Natural landscape.**
Try to explore details found within the natural environment. Capture scenes at dusk and dawn.
4. Explore abstract photography **Photograph 2 images that are highly ambiguous/abstract in nature.**
Try to explore details found in everyday life. Think about close up shots.
5. Explore a personal concept and **Photograph 5 images of your choice (Personal)**
In order for me to get to know you I would like you to showcase five of your best images taken on the holidays. I want these images to represent the photography that you are interested in and perhaps show me a little something about you!

You will need to annotate each photo.

- Describe where you went
- what you discovered
- and finally why & how you captured that specific image.
