- Read the two stories from the document "Esempi di storie creative". Then, choose one of the two stories and write a full review of it imagining that you are writing an article for the school newsletter where you recommend good reads for younger students.

If you won't show me evidence of completion of your work by the established dates I'll consider your homework not completed. Also, you need to have your folder subdivided in the recommended categories.
