

Request to offer a new subject

Subject *Vet Sport and Recreation (Certificate III)*

Year level: *VCE/VCAL (offered at year 11 initially with potential for year 12 class the following year)*

Rationale for offering this new subject

VET Sport and Recreation provides students with the opportunity to acquire and develop skills and knowledge to work in the areas of sport and community recreation. This subject provides an alternative to VCE Physical Education for students who may find the academic nature of Physical Education too challenging and will allow students to gain a scored assessment in year 12. It also provides another option for VCAL students needing to complete a VET subject.

Specific resources required for this subject:
